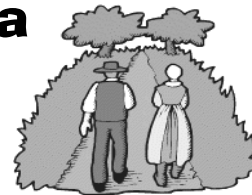




# Early Settlements in Upper Canada

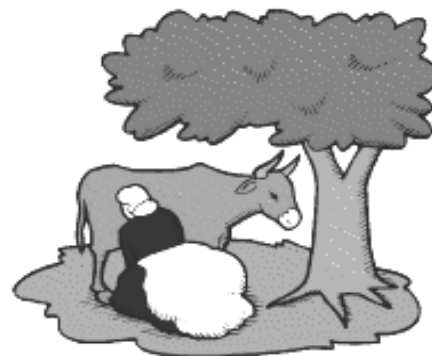
Learn where the pioneers came from and where they settled, and explore the important places in a pioneer village, from the saw mill and the grist mill to the family home and the general store.
